

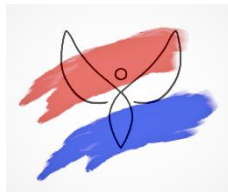

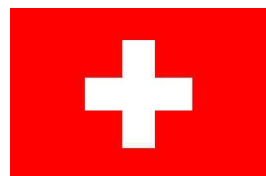
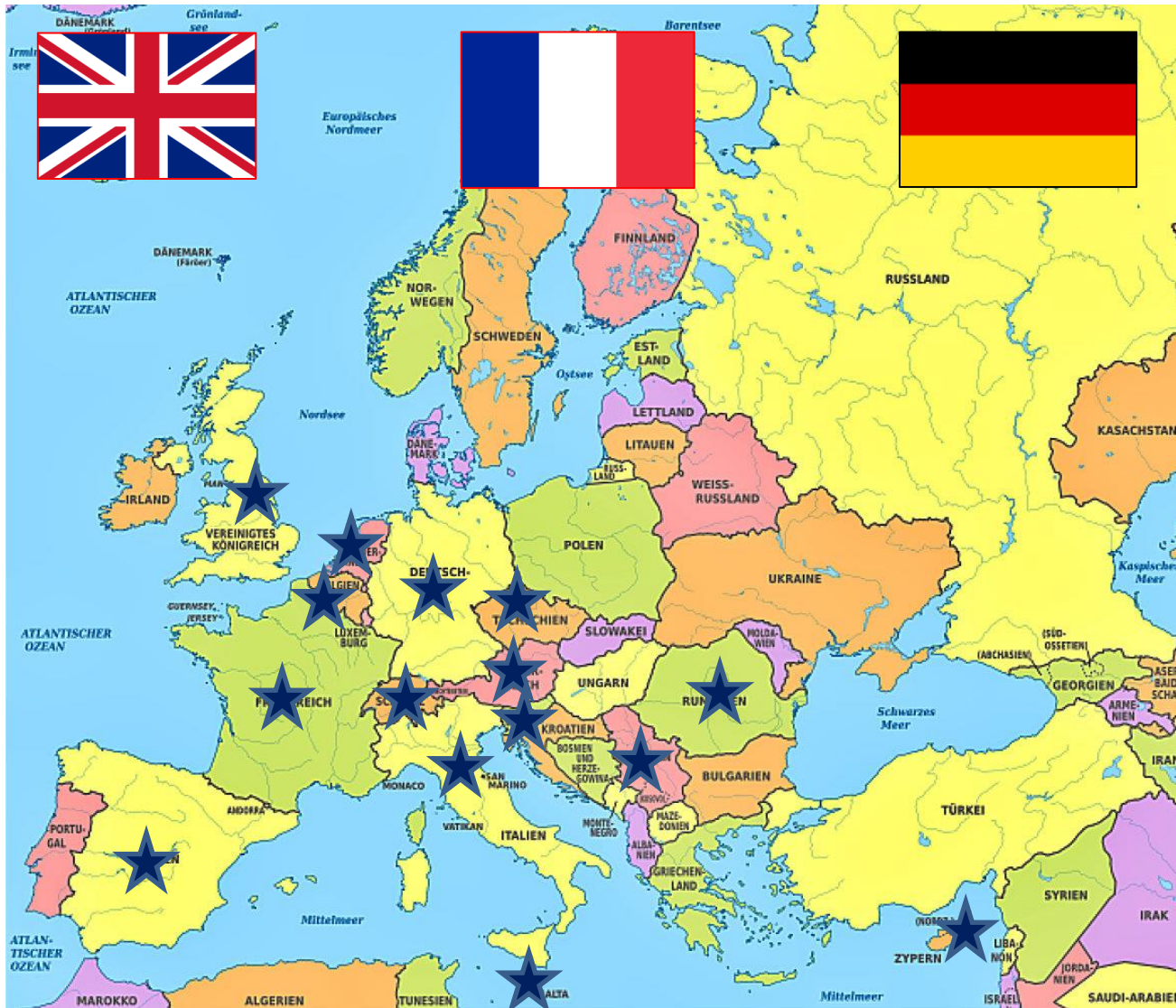

The association was founded in 1985 and has 56 active members.

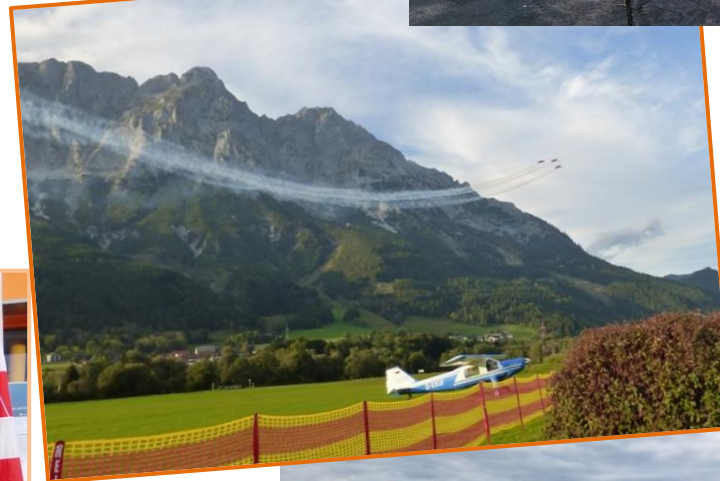
First aim: To inspire young women to fly: organising Fly Ins at all Austrian airfields.

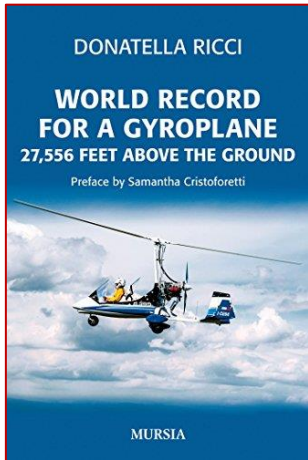
Fiorenza di Bernardi, Italy



Fiorenza is the daughter of Mario di Bernardi (famous testpilot) and the first female commercial (mountain)pilot in Italy. She flew Twin Otter, Yak-40 and DC8. She wrote a book about her life as a pilot. She is honorary member of FEWP and 91 years of age.

Famous members

Donatella Ricci, Italy and Caroline Gough-Cooper, UK



Donatella is the first Italian female president of the hot air balloon association, candidate for astronaut of ESA, and holds a high altitude record with Gyrocopter.



Caroline is a UK commercial pilot, flies F27, Lockheed Electra, Dash 8 series and won two gold medals on World Championships Helicopter with R22.
