



## **FEWP 2022 Belgrade – annual meeting – meet friends and make new friends**

The Federation of European Women Pilots experienced her annual meeting from June 3<sup>rd</sup> until 6<sup>th</sup> in and around the Serbian capital Belgrade. The weekend was organized by the representative of Serbia in the FEWP: Olgica Lazic and her co-workers of WAAS (Women Aeronautical Association of Serbia).

In the afternoon the program included an extensive bus ride (with lunch basket) to see the sights of Belgrade with stops at highlights. Dinner was served at the Aero Club where the management meeting took place as well.



The next day the group made a visit to the Aviation Academy in Vrsac and attended a classical lesson. It was also possible to make a test flight in a simulator.

After lunch the group went back to the hotel because there the Annual General Meeting of FEWP would take place.

During the management meeting as well as during the annual meeting the activities of all the countries and organisations were discussed. The restrictions of previous years by Covid were not noticeable anymore.

In the evening the group travelled to Skadarlia for the gala dinner in restaurant 'Three Hats'. The program on Sunday included a visit tot the museum 'Nikola Tesla' after which one could make a panoramic flight at the Aero Club. An UL airplane from the firm Magnus was demonstrated.



After lunch the group went back to the hotel where a farewell to all took place.

All together a full program to show all participants as much as possible of the surroundings, especially concerning aviation. The group was smaller than previous years, but that did not in any way temper the spirits.
